6. How to Prepare for Admission & Key Features

Korean Language Program:

- In addition to the documents listed in Section 7, please prepare supporting documents for your high school's internal and external activities. It will give you a great opportunity to receive a scholarship.

Undergraduate Programs:

- Applications can only be submitted online. Therefore, please check the list of admission documents on the website carefully and prepare them thoroughly before applying. This way, you can complete your application without any mistakes.

International College Programs:

- Applications can only be submitted online. A conditional admission system is available. If your language skills are not yet sufficient, you may be registered as a conditionally admitted student and improve your language ability. Once you are admitted, admission is guaranteed.

Graduate School (Master's Programs):

- Writing a thesis is optional. If you prefer not to write a thesis, you can earn additional credits instead. This allows you to graduate and receive your master's degree without any major difficulty.
- Graduate school applicants who wish to receive scholarships upon admission are advised to contact the Office of International Affairs for support.

Undergraduate Programs:

- Application form, Proof of language proficiency(Official TOPIK certificate, or score report from the university's internal TOPIK examination, or certificate of completion from a Korean language program at home or another university), Copy of passport, High school graduation certificate, High school academic transcript, University graduation certificate or certificate of completion (applicable to transfer applicants only), and university academic transcript (applicable to transfer applicants only), Family relationship certificate, Bank balance certificate(Minimum balance required: KRW 8,000,000 for applicants enrolled in the university's Korean language program; KRW 16,000,000 for applicants residing in Korea; USD 18,000 or more for applicants residing overseas), Passport-sized photograph, Certificate of attendance for the Korean language program, Copy of Alien Registration Card (not required for applicants residing overseas), Remittance receipt (for applicants residing overseas)
